## Best cheap eats

Brave the queue at **The Good Fortune Roast Duck House** (344 William St, Northbridge, 08 9228 3293) for big serves of roast duck, barbecue pork and noodles. At **Annalakshmi** (Jetty No 4, Barrack St, Perth, 08 9221 3003) you pay whatever you feel like for the vegetarian Indian buffet cooked by volunteers. At **The Flying Taco** (40 Angove St, North Perth, 08 9227 6393), less than 15 bucks buys a fat burrito filled with slow-cooked crisp pork, grilled fresh pineapple and your choice of

house-made salsa. All-you-can-eat tapas is the go at **The Gypsy Tapas House** (cnr High & Queen sts, Fremantle, 08 9336 7135), which serves tasty morsels such as marinated mushrooms and honey-drizzled Gorgonzola. The restaurant also has a very small but surprisingly sexy wine list. For modest Indonesian fare such as Balinese chicken at rock-bottom prices, head for **Sparrow** (434a William St, Northbridge, 08 9328 5660), but on weekends you'll need to get there early.
